

Mission - Main Effort


- Mobilize and Deploy
 - LNOs, CWTFs, Navigation teams
- Establish Accountability and Communications
 - HQ, Adjacent MSC, Subordinates, FEMA IV/V, MS/IL
 - Develop Common Operating Picture
 - Reorganize MVD to support
- Establish RSOI (MVK/MVR)
- Establish comms w/ USCG for MS River assessments
- Provide Mission Command
- Accomplish Specified, Implied, Essential Tasks

Support to FEMA

- LNOs to FEMA Region IV and V
- MVK Supports MS JFO:
 - PRT Gaps: Infrastructure Assmt, Temp Power, Commodities, 1-ECCV
 - LNO to MS SEOC
- MVR Supports IL JFO:
 - PRT Gaps: Debris, Infrastructure Assmt, Temp Power, Commodities, 1-ECCV
 - LNO to IL SEOC




St Paul & Rock Island Districts




