

P.L. 84-99

Preparedness funding (Category 100) is budgeted annually.

HQUSACE provides funding for Category 200 – 600 P.L. 84-99 activities on request from Major Subordinate Commands for each specific event.



Principle of USACE Emergency Assistance:

USACE emergency assistance will be undertaken to supplement state and local efforts.

- Field investigations & reconnaissance of flood potential
- Flood Fighting
 - Technical Assistance
 - Furnishing Materials
 - Rescue Operations
 - Emergency Contracting
- Post Flood Response
 - Emergency debris clearance
 - Temporary restoration of critical transportation routes and public services and utilities
 - After Action Review & Reporting

- Repair active Federal flood risk management projects - (100% Federal)
- Repair active Non-Federal flood risk management projects - (cost shared 80 % Federal, 20% local)
- Repair any Federally constructed coastal storm damage reduction projects
- Will not repair deferred maintenance




- Preventive temporary works executed prior to predicted unusual flooding
- Examples:
 - Creating a ring levee around critical facilities
 - Adding height or reinforcing existing levees
